RECREATION AREA CAR PARK

We hope you agree that the Recreation Area car park is a fantastic improvement. Our appreciation goes to Matt and Chris and the Core Groundworks team for executing such a fine job with minimal inconvenience to the teams that use the field.

NEW 'NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL'

Following the government consultation on reorganisation, it was announced in July 2021 that the current county, district and borough councils would be replaced by a new single council for North Yorkshire in April 2023 with City of York Council remaining as it is.

The new council will officially start in April 2023. Until then, services will continue to be provided by NYCC and the seven district or borough councils.

The Structural Changes Order laid before Parliament in January 2022 has been enacted and it states the new authority will be called "North Yorkshire Council" and that 90 new councillors will represent 89 divisions across the county. **The elections for these Councillors will take place in May 2022. Parish Council elections have been brought forward a year to coincide with the County elections.**

Hambleton Isolation Help Group

We are delighted to say that our registered volunteers are still helping people who are isolating for any reason and we will continue to do so at least until Easter despite the lifting the restrictions by the Government.

Although no longer mandatory the Government guidance issued on 24th February was:

- If you test positive stay at home and avoid mixing with other people
- Test five days after symptoms appear
- If you have two negative tests you can return to normal activity.

A further update to the guidance is planned for 1st April.



If you are isolating, whatever your age, and need help with shopping, collection from the Selby Food Bank or collecting prescriptions just ring one of the numbers below and we will put you in contact with a volunteer. Your details will only be shared with the volunteer. If you have had a positive COVID 19 test please tell the person you phone so that the volunteer is aware before they contact you.

Some of the phone coordinators are still working so you may need to leave a message but we will get back to you.

Finding Hambleton's Hidden History Project**

The two research sessions for the project held in February & March went well and we are now identifying sites for further research.

We are hoping to use a drone, with specialist software, to photograph various areas already identified by Historic England and other sites. Land owners will be asked for permission to overfly their land out of courtesy.

We are also planning to undertake geophysical surveys and permission is already being sought from relevant land owners. If you would be interested in participating in the geophysical surveys please contact us or come to the AGM and register your interest.

Although we are now undertaking our second project we continue to collect photos and information to add to the website, this is now taking a little longer as there needs to be more research to get the information associated with the photos.
