PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

These pages will give you an update on what the Parish Council have been dealing with and any issues that have been brought to our attention. Parish Council Meetings are held every second Thursday of the month, check the Notice Board for the most recent Minutes. The next meeting Agenda will be posted 3 days in advance of the meeting on the Notice Board.



POLICE IN HAMBLETON

PCSO SIMPSON has been regularly in contact with the Parish Council and continues to follow up any reports we give her directly.

There have been 2 incidents of drivers damaging the car park surface recently.

CCTV and number plate details have been submitted and the Police have visited the drivers at their home to explain the problem with this behaviour.

The Parish Council will continue to assess the situation but further occurrences and blatant disregard for the facilities will result in prosecution. There is a clear sign up now too.

Over summer a large group of teenagers were gathering at the Recreation Area in the evening, the behaviour witnessed resulted a member of the public calling the police. Simple peer pressure and bravado had this group of boys getting up to mischief and disturbing the village! The police increased patrols along Old Lane to keep an eye on the situation and we have CCTV should it be needed.

Remember, if you have any concerns about anti social or suspicious behaviour, local scams or thefts or want an update on crimes that have been reported in Hambleton and the surrounding villages, please do drop in to the Village Hall to chat:

PLANNING, GATEFORTH LANE

FOLLOWING THE PRESENTATION to the Parish Council and the public consultation at the Owl, Banks Group now intend to submit a formal planning application into the local planning department. Once this happens, there will be an opportunity for everyone to submit their comments on the application.

It was made clear that Hambleton residents do not want another development in the village, but this won't make them change their mind about this site. Please look out for our Facebook posts which will tell you when the application has been validated and is ready for comments. We will also post information about 'material considerations', these are a list of valid reasons for an objection to any planning application.

PEDESTRIAN REFUGE UPDATE

NORTH YORKSHIRE HIGHWAYS have come back to say the current plan to widen an existing refuge at the bus stop is not viable, they have decided to build a brand new refuge in between the 2 existing ones outside the Red Lion.

The Red Lion management are satisfied this will not be too much of an inconvenience and believe that the benefit of a wider refuge outweighs the downsides.

Moving the wider refuge away from the Chapel Street turn will mean farm vehicles are not affected by the narrower carriageway, which had been a concern, and an additional obstacle in the road may well make drivers take a little more caution as the carriageway narrows.

DOGS IN THE CEMETERY

DOGS are welcome in the cemetery when visiting loved ones, but it is NOT a dog exercise field. Playing fetch across the cemetery does not lend itself to a peaceful place of reflection where people go to mourn and grieve.

The Walmsley's dog field in the village is available as an enclosed space to exercise your dogs without causing upset to others.



Greetings from St Mary's.

Interviews for a new Vicar for St Mary's are planned for late October and we pray that with God's help we will find our new priest-in-charge. Whoever may be appointed will also be the Vicar for the Parishes of Haddlesey and also Carlton & Drax.

The Churchwarden's term of office having ended, life goes on. The PCC acts collegiately as we continue in Interregnum.

The new School term has started, and our work with Open the Book has resumed. Already we are planning with the school for their Christmas Services. On Friday 24th November, The Team will go into school for the annual Christingle making. There will be the short Christingle slide show in the Village Hall **at 5pm** on the Saturday on behalf of the Children's Society, after which the Village Lights 'switch-on' takes place on the Village Green. This year children can also bring their Christingles to the short Family Prayer service on the Sunday afternoon when they will be able to light their Christingles in the church.

Our 1st Saturday monthly coffee mornings continue in Allison's kitchen – from 9:30am to 11am – tea/coffee, cake, a raffle, and fellowship – much enjoyed by those who come and a welcome addition to much needed church funds – why not consider joining us – you may find you enjoy it!
