PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

These pages will give you an update on what the Parish Council have been dealing with and any issues that have been brought to our attention. Parish Council Meetings are held every second Thursday of the month, check the Notice Board for the most recent Minutes. The next meeting Agenda will be posted 3 days in advance of the meeting on the Notice Board.

FATAL COLLISIONS A63 HAMBLETON

A woman lost her life trying to cross the road in Hambleton on 8th January. This is an absolute tragedy and the Parish Councillors extend their heartfelt sympathies to the family. It follows a car collision in a similar spot only weeks previous, and a fatal accident only 3 months earlier where a bus and a car collided just outside of Hambleton towards Monk Fryston. When will Highways accept the amount of traffic on this road is dangerous enough without additional developments in the villages along the route to exacerbate the problem, and start giving our community some protection against it?

PLANNING MATTERS

The saga continues, as North Yorkshire Council delay the submission of the 'New Selby Local Plan' which makes us all think the Planning Department might actually be considering the Comments we've submitted - however, a revised copy of the pre-submission draft shows the direct opposite has happened. If you are reading this online, you can see the Draft <u>here</u>, page 246, which shows the ADDITION of site 'Hamb-A'. This draft will go to public consultation, at which point the PC hopes you will submit comments to ensure they know how you feel about this.

Thank you to all those that attended the forum. The PC took on board all the comments and shared these with our Planning Consultant who has so far submitted observations on two proposals on behalf of the PC. Their services will be employed for the incoming major applications as the PC tries to do everything in its power to protect our Village.

The more voices that are heard the better - say your piece.

COMMUNITY LED NEIGHBOUR PLAN

We may be able to help protect and shape our village for the future by creating a Neighbourhood Plan. These Plans hold weight when it comes to granting/refusing planning permission but they must be community led. If we can get a group together, and a leader, the PC can help facilitate the process. Unfortunately, the last time the PC appealed for a community group to do this, it didn't take off - we really need a few motivated individuals to take this on.

DOG ATTACK ON SHEEP

Disturbingly, there have been numerous instances where famers are seeing dogs off lead and not in close control amongst livestock. Farmers have reported getting abuse when telling the dog owners to get their dogs back. One recent attack resulted in 2 dead sheep and 6 ewes aborting. In addition to this loss are the expenses incurred in vet treatment and rescanning the remaining sheep. Hambleton is a farming village, farming is the livelihood of many of our residents and it is out of order to disrespect that. We all love our canine companions, so why risk their safety letting them run where there are electric fences or even getting shot by a farmer protecting their livestock?

We are also looking at further archaeological investigation to learn more about our early history, so watch this space. The initial investigation will be geophysical surveys led by Dr. Jon Kenny, we are in the process of gaining the land owners permission for 3 potential sites.






