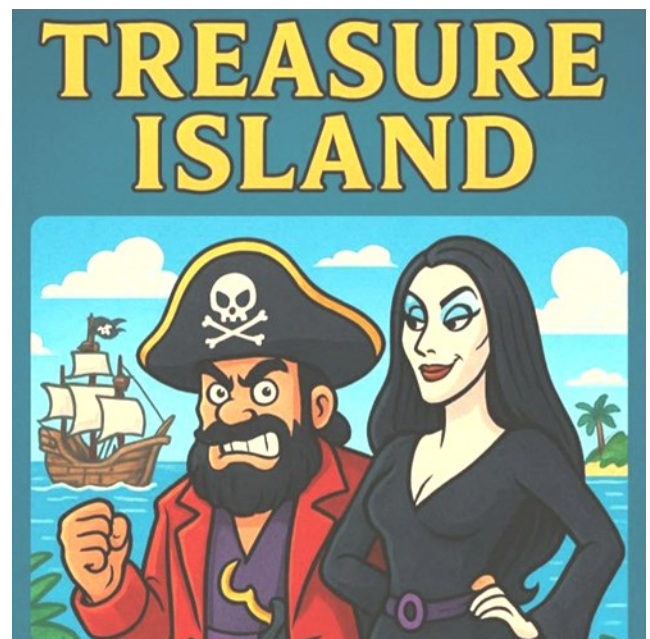


We have SOLD OUT again for **Breakfast with Santa** this year! If you didn't manage to bag a ticket, please put your name on the waiting list - just in case!

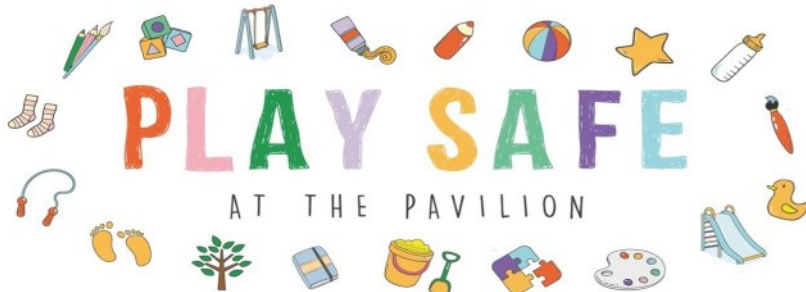

## COMMUNITY GOVERNANCE REVIEW INFORMATION

### **YOUR HOME IS IN THE HAMBLETON PARISH.** **HAMBLETON PARISH IS AFFECTED BY A CURRENT** **'COMMUNITY GOVERNANCE REVIEW' (CGR).**

Thorpe Willoughby Parish Council have requested the boundary be moved which would move some of Hambleton Parish and Gateforth Parish in to Thorpe Willoughby.

The review is open for Public Consultation and you are entitled to voice your opinion to aid the decision. **The deadline for this is Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> December.**

### **AT A RECENT RESIDENTS MEETING ON THE SUBJECT, THE FOLLOWING CONCERNS ABOUT THE CHANGE WERE RAISED:**

"Hambleton residents pay lower precept rates (council tax) and are eligible to be buried in the Hambleton Cemetery – if the boundary changes, those affected will lose those benefits of being a Hambleton resident"

"Affected properties would be in a Smoke Control Area and a number of residents heat their properties with woodburning/multifuel burners"

"It was felt the only reason a change was requested is so the potential precept income from housing developments in the 2 areas would go to Thorpe Willoughby instead of Hambleton or Gateforth"

"Hambleton would lose precept income because the number of households in the parish would be reduced"

"This is the only CGR where the initiating parish is proposing taking land from neighbouring parishes"

"A new road should not dictate a parish boundary. The by-pass proposed as the new boundary line was not something that Hambleton had control over or benefitted from; Hambleton would lose out again"

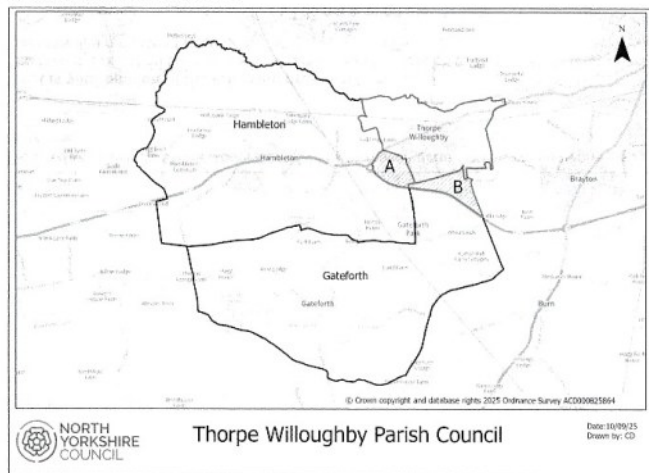
## Community Governance Review for Thorpe Willoughby, Hambleton and Gateforth

North Yorkshire Council is undertaking a community governance review of the parishes of Thorpe Willoughby, Hambleton and Gateforth.

A request has been received from Thorpe Willoughby Parish Council that the south western boundary of the parish be moved so that it runs alongside the bypass. Those parts of Hambleton and Gateforth parishes currently inside the bypass would then form part of Thorpe Willoughby. These two areas of land can only be accessed through the village of Thorpe Willoughby and any homes built on those areas of land would be considered to be a part of Thorpe Willoughby.

New housing has been built in the area of land to the west which is in Hambleton parish. CIL and S106 monies from the new housing will be allocated to Hambleton Parish Council.

A previous planning application for housing to the south, in Gateforth parish, has been rejected, but further applications may be made.



In undertaking a community governance review, the council is required to ensure that governance arrangements within an area are reflective of the identities and interests of that area and that it is effective and convenient.

The council must also take account of the views of local people and residents and other interested parties are invited to have their say on the proposals by taking part in this consultation.
